COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – SBC CALIFORNIA, 14709 VANOWEN STREET, VAN NUYS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG990002, WDID #4000U000096)

We have completed our review of your Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the terms of the Statewide General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Based on the attached NOI provided, we have determined that the submitted NOI application is complete. Therefore, you are authorized to discharge under Water Quality Order No. 2001-11-DWQ, *Statewide General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Discharges from Utility Vaults and Underground Structures to Surface Waters (General Permit)*, adopted by the SWRCB on July 19, 2001.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your NPDES permit, consisting of Water Quality Order No. 2001-11-DWQ and Monitoring and Reporting Program. The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit.
