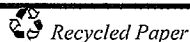

Consideration of the proposed Basin Plan amendment will be at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 A.M., Thursday, November 1, 2007 at Simi Valley City Hall, Council Chambers; 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California.

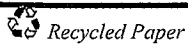
