REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS (WRRs) & RESPONSE TO COMMENTS – CITY OF BURBANK, BURBANK WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (FILE NO. 83-25, CI-6753)

On February 22, 2016, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff sent you a tentative revision of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Water Reclamation Requirements (WRRs) for the above-mentioned Water Reclamation Plant. On March 1, 2016, Regional Water Board staff sent you a letter informing you about the change of venue for the upcoming meeting. Regional Water Board staff considered comments submitted by the March 23, 2016, public comment deadline and prepared the enclosed written response to comments table and Revised Tentative WDRs/WRRs.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on **April 14, 2016, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the **City of Simi Valley, Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California**, will consider the enclosed Revised Tentative WDRs/WRRs and comments submitted in writing regarding the changes contained within the proposed amended Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
