**TENTATIVE ORDER – TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR MONTALVO COMMUNITY SERVICE DISTRICT (MONTALVO WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT), 3555 VENTURA ROAD, MONTALVO, CALIFORNIA 93003 (FILE NO. 54-052, ORDER NO. 97-037, CI-5068, GLOBAL ID WDR100000097)**

Dear Ms. Dorrington:

On April 23, 1979, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) contained in Order No. 79-075 to regulate the discharge of treated wastewater from the Montalvo Water Pollution Control Plant (MWPCP) at 3555 Ventura Road, Montalvo, California, which received domestic wastewater from the Montalvo community. The WDRs were subsequently renewed on June 22, 1987 (Order No. 87-092) and December 13, 1997 (Order No. 97-037).

On February 22, 2016, the City of Ventura notified Regional Water Board staff that wastewater from the Montalvo community has been completely diverted to the Ventura Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). In March 2016, the MWPCP was decommissioned and the plant was demolished in May 2016. Because waste discharge has ceased and the MWPCP has been demolished, the Regional Water Board finds that Order No. 97-037 is no longer needed and may be terminated, except for purposes of enforcement.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Water Board, at a public hearing, will consider the enclosed tentative Order, which will terminate Order No. 97-037. The meeting will be held on November 14, 2019, beginning at 9:00 a.m., at the City of Monrovia, 415 South Ivy Avenue, Monrovia, California.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Water Board staff and included in the Regional Water Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received by the Regional Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on October 28, 2019**. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Regional Water Board to refuse to admit the proposed

written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Water Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Water Board Members have sufficient time to fully consider the comments and issues raised.
