Written comments or exhibits regarding this Order must be received at the Los Angeles Water Board office by **5:00 pm on May 20, 2022**. Failure to comply with this

requirement provides grounds for the Los Angeles Water Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comments or exhibit the evidence (title 23 CCR Section 648.2). If materials are not submitted in a timely manner, the Los Angeles Water Board may refuse to admit written testimony into evidence unless the proponent can demonstrate why they were unable to submit the material on time or that compliance with the deadline would otherwise create a hardship. If any other party demonstrates prejudice resulting from admission of written testimony or exhibits not timely submitted, the Los Angeles Water Board may refuse to admit it.
