TENTATIVE ORDER - TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SAN MIGUEL PRODUCE, 4444 NAVALAIR ROAD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA 93003 (FILE NO. 04-168, ORDER NO. R4-2019-0064, CI-9784, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100002214)

Dear Ms. Berk:

On June 10, 2019, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) Adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and Water Reclamation Requirements (WRRs) contained in Order No. R4-2019-0064 to regulate the discharge of treated wastewater from the San Miguel Produce wastewater treatment system and its recycled water application at 4444 Navalair Road, Oxnard, California.

On May 1, 2020, you notified Regional Water Board staff that all vegetable washing/processing operations at the Navalair Road facility had ended and that all non-domestic wastewater discharges had ceased on March 20, 2020. Because waste discharge has ceased and the facility is no longer generating wastewater from washing/processing vegetables, the Regional Water Board finds that Order No. R4-2019-0064 is no longer needed and may be terminated, except for purposes of enforcement.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Water Board, at a public hearing, will consider the enclosed tentative order, which will terminate Order No. R4-2019-0064. The meeting will be held via video and teleconference only on June 11, 2020, beginning at 9:00. For additional information regarding observing or participating in the public hearing please contact the Regional Water Board staff noted below.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Water Board staff and included in the Regional Water Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received by the

Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Regional Water Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Water Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Water Board Members have sufficient time to fully consider the comments and issues raised.
