TENTATIVE ORDER - TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR 76 STATION NO. 6907 AT 11025 EAST WASHINGTON BOULEVARD, WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R04-018, CI-8841)

On December 13, 2004, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), Order No. R04-018 for discharge to remediate contaminated groundwater at former 76 Station No. 6907 located at 11025 East Washington Boulevard, Whittier.

On June 12, 2009, Discharger notified this Regional Board that there are no discharges into groundwater at the site, and requested termination of WDR. Regional Board staff verified this, by reviewing the file and data, and determined that a WDR is no longer needed.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Board, at a public hearing, will consider the enclosed tentative Order, which, in part, will terminate WDR Order No. R04-018. The hearing will be held on March 4, 2010, at Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California and will begin at 9:00 a.m.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Board staff and included in the Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board office by 10:00 a.m. on February 18, 2010. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Board Members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.

TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to groundwater basins in Los Angeles Region for the Dischargers listed below.
2. These Dischargers have ceased their discharges to groundwater basins.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements are no longer necessary and shall be terminated.
4. The following Orders are hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The termination of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider termination of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
