WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CALABASAS LANDFILL, AGOURA HILLS, CA (FILE NO. 60-118)

Dear Mr. Louie:

Reference is made to our letter dated March 20, 2009, regarding the proposed amending of the Waste Discharge Requirements (Regional Board Order No. 89-053, adopted May 22, 1989) for the Calabasas Landfill (Landfill). The tentative waste discharge requirements (WDRs) were released for public comment on February 17, 2009 with a March 10, 2009 comment deadline. Subsequently, the Regional Board public meeting date was revised from April 2, 2009, to May 7, 2009 and the public comment period was extended through April 14, 2009. Regional Board staff has responded to the comments and has revised the tentative WDRs pursuant to all comments received. A hard copy of the revised tentative WDRs (Attachment 1) and comments/responses (Attachment 2) are being provided to commenters. An revised electronic the tentative WDRS can http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/rwqcb4/html/permits/ all tentative permits.html and a hard copy of these comments/responses and revised tentative WDRs can be furnished to any interested party upon request.

For your information, revisions to the tentative Order are in a bold format for comments received per the March 10, 2009 deadline and in an italicized format for comments received per the April 14, 2009 deadline. All deletions are in a strike-out format. You are also alerted that based on further consideration by Regional Board staff, the uninvolved constituents of concern list (Table 3 of the monitoring and reporting program CI-4992) has been expanded to include emergent chemicals (perchlorate, N-nitrosodimethylamine, 1,4-Dioxane, and 1,2,3-Trichloropropane).

You are reminded that the public meeting will start on May 7, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., at the Ventura County Government Center Hearing Room, located at 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California, 93009. The meeting will continue on May 8, 2009, beginning at 9:00 a.m. Because of timing uncertainties on the agenda, anyone who wants to participate in the public meeting should be prepared to present both days.
