REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND TITLE 22 WATER RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS (WRRs), AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR CITY OF LOS ANGELES, HARBOR WATER RECYCLING PROJECT, DOMINGUEZ GAP BARRIER PROJECT (CI NO. 8654, FILE NO. 97-208)

The Regional Water Board staff has revised the tentative WDRs/WRRs dated August 16, 2016, based on comments received by the September 15, 2016, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs/WRRs appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.

The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this revised tentative Order. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
