In addition, to the changes made in response to comments, minor clarifications have been made to the revised tentative WDR Order, all of which appear in the strikeout/underline format.

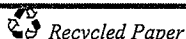
In accordance with the California Water Code, revised tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared.


