TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, TRANCAS WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT AT 6338 PASEO CANYON DRIVE, MALIBU, CA (ORDER NO. 2023-XXXX, FILE NO. 61-061, CI-3017, GEOTRACKER GLOBAL ID WDR100018599)

Dear William J. Winter:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) is the public agency with primary responsibility for the protection of groundwater and surface water quality for all beneficial uses of water within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the referenced property above.

On September 11, 2014, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. R4-2014-0188 for the Trancas Water Pollution Control Plant (Trancas WPCP) owned and operated by the Los Angeles County, Department of Public Works. Pursuant to the California Water Code Section 13263(e), all waste discharge requirements are reviewed periodically, and, upon such review, may be revised by the Regional Water Board. Following a review of the Report of Waste Discharge, dated May 13, 2019, and the existing requirements contained in WDR Order No. R4-2014-0188, a tentative revised WDRs Order and revised monitoring and reporting program (MRP) have been prepared.

Enclosed are copies of the Tentative WDRs consisting of:

- a. Tentative Regional Water Board Order No. R4-2023-XXXX specifying WDRs;
- b. Tentative revised MRP No. CI-3017; and
- c. Attachments A to D.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Water Board is scheduled to consider the enclosed tentative WDRs and MRP and comments timely received at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 a.m. on June 22, 2023, at the Junipero Serra Building (Carmel Room), 320 West 4th Street, Los Angeles, California, 90013. The Regional Water Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Regional Water Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Regional Water Board at its discretion may order further investigation.

In order to be evaluated by Regional Water Board staff and included in the Regional Water Board members' agenda packets, written comments or evidence regarding these tentative WDRs/MRP **must be received at the Regional Water Board's office by 5:00 p.m. on May 30, 2023**. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Regional Water Board to refuse to admit the proposed written comment or evidence into the record. Therefore, timely submittal of written comments is required to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Water Board staff is able to provide timely review and time to respond to comments, and that Regional Water Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
