RESPONSE TO COMMENTS ON TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, TRANCAS WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PLANT AT 6338 PASEO CANYON DRIVE, MALIBU, CA (ORDER NO. 2023-XXXX, FILE NO. 61-061, CI-3017, GEOTRACKER GLOBAL ID WDR100018599)

Dear Martin Moreno:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) is the public agency with primary responsibility for the protection of ground and surface water quality for all beneficial uses of water within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the Trancas Water Pollution Control Plant (Trancas WCPC) located at 6338 Paseo Canyon Drive, Malibu, CA (Site).

On May 1, 2023, the Los Angeles Water Board released the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Trancas WPCP for public review and comment. The deadline to submit written comments was May 30, 2023. The Los Angeles Water Board received written comments from Los Angeles County Public Works (LACPW) and the Malibu West Homeowner Association (HOA) members. Los Angeles Water Board staff has considered all the comment received and revised the revised tentative WDRs and monitoring and reporting program (MRP) No. CI-3017 accordingly.
