NOTICE OF BOARD MEMBER ATTENDANCE AT THE SANTA SUSANA STORMWATER EXPERT PANEL SITE TOUR AND OFF-SITE PUBLIC MEETING

This is notice that Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) members Norma Camacho and James Stahl will be participating in the upcoming Santa Susana Stormwater Expert Panel (Expert Panel) site tour and public meeting for the Santa Susana Field Laboratory, a former rocket engine and energy test site. The Expert Panel is the host of the site tour and the public meeting. The Expert Panel was formed at the direction of the Los Angeles Water Board to provide technical oversight to Boeing on the evaluation, selection and implementation of best management practices (BMPs) to treat stormwater discharges from the SSFL site. The Expert Panel also provides technical oversight on water quality monitoring to evaluate the effectiveness of the BMPs in treating stormwater runoff leaving the site. As part of their role, and because of the significant interest and concern about stormwater runoff from the site, the Expert Panel holds community meetings periodically to discuss BMP implementation at the site, and the surface water quality monitoring data from the prior year. The Expert Panel will discuss the results of the surface water quality monitoring that was conducted during the 2021-2022 storm season at the November 17th meeting.

The site tour will be held in person from 1:00 PM – 4:00PM and will be followed by a public meeting to be held at the Grand Vista Hotel in Simi Valley, CA, from 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM on November 17, 2022.

Issuance of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the Santa Susana Field Laboratory is a pending adjudicative proceeding before the Los Angeles Water Board. During the tour and meeting, issues related to the pending proceeding may be discussed. For example, operation of the various BMPs may be discussed.
