TRANSMITTAL OF RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR THE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CALLEGUAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, REGIONAL SALINITY MANAGEMENT PIPELINE (RSMP), VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0064521)

On April 15, 2019, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) transmitted the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the subject Facility. Comments were submitted by the Calleguas Municipal Water District and the Camrosa Water District before the comment period deadline on May 16, 2019. The Regional Water Board considered the comments submitted and is providing responses to the comments (enclosed). Changes were made based on comments received. Changes in the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit appear in the strikeout/underline format.

In accordance with administrative procedure, the Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on June 13, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., at the City of Camarillo, at 601 Carmen Drive, Camarillo, California, will consider the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit. If no additional comments or only supportive comments regarding the changes made in the revised tentative are received prior to the public hearing, the revised tentative permit may be placed on the Board's consent calendar and approved without oral testimony. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.
