The Regional Water Board staff has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated April 16, 2020, based on comments received by the May 18, 2020, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit appear in ~~strikeout~~ and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.
