
Dear Ms. Radde:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated December 18, 2018, based on comments received by the January 17, 2019, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.
