**CHANGE SHEET TO REVISED TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER, AND REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) – CITY OF REDONDO BEACH – SEASIDE LAGOON (NPDES NO. CA0064297, CI NO. 8034)**

Our letter dated May 23, 2017, transmitted the revised tentative Order and revised tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the City of Redondo Beach, Seaside Lagoon. Regional Water Board staff made some changes in the revised tentative WDRs and the revised tentative TSO. The changes, which are included in the attached change sheet, are summarized below:

1. Table E-3 on Page E-7 of Monitoring and Reporting Program, the frequency of monitoring of total residual chlorine has been increased to twice per week from once per week.
2. Table 3 on page 7 of TSO, the strikeout for Average Monthly Interim Effluent Limitations has been undeleted. Footnote 3 has been added to the Average Monthly heading that states that the interim daily maximum limitations applies to all samples.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Board is scheduled to consider the Revised Tentative National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Order and Revised Tentative TSO, including the attached changes at the Board Hearing scheduled for June 1, 2017, at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California.
