TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CITY OF SIMI VALLEY, SIMI VALLEY WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0055221, CI NO. 3021) – APPROVAL OF THE PRETREATMENT PROGRAM

We have completed our review of your application and your request to continue implementing the Pretreatment Program with modifications. On June 15, 2003, the Board adopted Order No. R4-2003-0081 (as revised by Order No. R4-2004-0121), NPDES No. CA0055221, renewing waste discharge requirements for the City of Simi Valley — Simi Valley Water Quality Control Plant (Simi Valley WQCP). Order No. R4-2003-0081 (as revised by Order No. R4-2004-0121) requires Simi Valley WQCP to implement and enforce the Pretreatment Program. Regional Board staff determined that the modifications to the Pretreatment Program, as submitted in the application, were substantial and will require approval at a Board Hearing. Accordingly, we have prepared tentative WDRs to amend the Order and approve the modified Pretreatment Program.

Pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the California Water Code, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared.

Enclosed are copies of the following:

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on June 2, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., at Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California, will consider the enclosed tentative requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding any and all portions thereof. The Board will hear any

testimony pertinent to this discharge and the tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.

Written comments regarding this tentative Order must be received at the Regional Board office by the close of business on **May 12, 2011**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will be provided, ex agenda, to the Board for their consideration. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised. Comments received after the requested date may result in delay in consideration of the tentative Order.

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and the California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for publication or posting of the notice not later than April 15, 2011.

Failure to publish or post the notice by the above date may require us to reschedule this item for a later hearing and will require the publication or posting of a second notice. Please notify this Board by telephone when the notice has been published and submit the proof of publication or posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting or publication of the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Board no later than May 12, 2011.
