On September 18, 2018, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) transmitted the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for Equilon Enterprises LLC dba Shell Oil Products US (Discharger), Shell Oil Products US-Carson Distribution Facility (Facility). Regional Board staff considered comments submitted on October 19, 2018, by the Discharger. Enclosed are our Response to Comments and the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit. Changes in the revised tentative requirements appear in the ~~strikeout~~/underline format.
