On May 4, 2020, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) transmitted the Revised Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and the Response to Comments to the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (Discharger) for wastewater discharges from the Marine Tank Farm (Facility) to the Los Angeles Inner Harbor. The Regional Water Board has continued to discuss with the Discharger their comment request to delete the receiving water monitoring program and subsequently developed a change sheet to revise the visual monitoring requirement at the discharge to the harbor.
