

REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT - CITY OF LOS ANGELES. LOS ANGELES-GLENDALE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0053953, CI NO. 5675)

On August 4, 2011, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff sent you the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the abovementioned Wastewater Treatment Plant. Regional Water Board staff considered comments submitted by Discharger, Heal the Bay, and United States Environmental Protection Agency by the September 6, 2011, public comment deadline. Where appropriate, the tentative Order is modified to reflect such changes. Enclosed are the following:

- 1. Revised Tentative for the NPDES permit: (Additions are underlined; deletions are lined over.)
 - a. Waste Discharge Requirements;
 - b. Monitoring and Reporting Program;
 - c. Fact Sheet:
 - d. Attachment J; and,

Additional comments on the revised tentative WDRs will only be accepted if they pertain to revisions made to the enclosed revised Order. Written comments regarding the revised tentative WDRs must be received at the Regional Water Board office by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on November 4. 2011, in order to be evaluated by Regional Water Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date would be provided, ex agenda, to the Board for their consideration. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Regional Water Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised. Comments received after the requested date may result in delay in consideration of the tentative Order.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Water Board will conduct a hearing on these matters at a Board meeting to be held on **December 8, 2011**, at 9:00 a.m., at the Metropolitan Water District Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this Order. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.
