NRG California South LP, owner of the Ormond Beach Generating Station (OBGS), offers the following comments on the Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRS) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0001198, issued July 17, 2015. NRG California South LP is a wholly owned subsidiary of NRG Energy Inc. (NRG). OBGS's current NPDES permit (Order No. 01-192) was issued June 28, 2001. OBGS has operated on the administrative extension of CA0001198 since its expiration on May 10, 2006.

NRG California South LP has thoroughly reviewed the Tentative WDRS and NPDES Permit for OBGS and is supportive of Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board staff's analysis and the resulting permit conditions. We recommend approval of this Tentative Permit and the associated Monitoring and Reporting Program.
