
**REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR NRG CALIFORNIA SOUTH LP, ORMOND BEACH GENERATING STATION, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0001198, CI NO. 5619)**

On July 17, 2015, we transmitted the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for NRG California South LP, Ormond Beach Generating Station. Regional Water Board staff considered comments submitted by Wishtoyo Foundation on August 17, 2015, and by NRG California South LP on August 18, 2015. Staff also made other changes based on internal review. Enclosed are the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit. Changes in the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES Permit appear in the strikeout/underline format.

In accordance with administrative procedure, the Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **September 10, 2015**, at 9:00 a.m., at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, will consider the enclosed revised tentative WDRs and NPDES Permit. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.
