REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR NEWHALL RANCH SANITATION DISTRICT – NEWHALL RANCH WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NEWHALL RANCH WRP), (NPDES NO. CA0064556, CI#9322)

The Regional Water Board has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated January 16, 2019, after further internal review and based on comments received by the February 15, 2019, public comment deadline. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order

Written comments pertaining to the revised tentative NPDES Order must be received at the Regional Water Board office by **5:00 p.m. on May 6, 2019**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Comments received after that date will not be considered, absent extraordinary circumstances. Timely submittal of written comments is required to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and the California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for publication or posting of the notice no later than **April 15, 2019**.

Failure to publish or post the notice by the above date may require us to reschedule this item for a later hearing and will require the publication or posting of a second notice. Please notify this Board by telephone when the notice has been published and submit the proof of publication or posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting or publication of the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Water Board no later than **April 22**, **2019**.
