RESPONSE TO COMMENTS - REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – ORMOND BEACH POWER, LLC, ORMOND BEACH GENERATING STATION, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0001198, CI 5619)

Dear Mr. Di Ciolli:

On September 18, 2020, a tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the Ormond Beach Power, LLC (Discharger), Ormond Beach Generating Station (Facility), were released for public comment. The comment period ended on October 19, 2020. A comment letter was received from the Heal the Bay on October 19, 2020. A TSO Withdraw Request letter was received from the Discharger on October 28, 2020. Regional Water Board staff has considered all comments submitted, made appropriate revisions to the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit accordingly and prepared the Response to Comments.

Since the tentative TSO request has been witdrawn, the tentative TSO will no longer be considered.
