**REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON THE TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT RENEWAL AND TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) – ORMOND BEACH POWER, LLC, ORMOND BEACH GENERATING STATION, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0001198, CI 5619)**

Dear Mr. Di Ciolli:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) has completed a review of the application for the renewal of your permit to discharge waste under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program. Pursuant to the federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the Porter Cologne Water Quality Control Act, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared.

In addition, in response to your request we have also prepared the tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) relative to this discharge that will be considered along with the tentative waste discharge requirements at the same hearing. Copies of the tentative requirements, tentative TSO and Public Notice are enclosed.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held at the Board's regularly scheduled meeting on **November 12, 2020, remote meeting, no physical location, at 9:00 a.m.**, will consider the enclosed tentative waste discharge requirements, tentative TSO, and comments thereof. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to these waste discharge requirements and TSO. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing, however, as testimony dictates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.

untimely submittal of written comments or evidence will not be allowed or accepted into the Administrative Record without a showing of good cause for the delay, and in no event if any party or the Board would be unduly prejudiced by the late submittal including if staff or the Regional Water Board would not have an adequate opportunity to review, consider, and prepare responses to the comments or evidence. Additionally, if the Board receives only supportive comments, the permit may be placed on the Board's consent calendar and approved without oral testimony.
