REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CITY OF OXNARD MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OXNARD WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0054097, CI NO. 2022)

We have revised the tentative NPDES permit dated April 5, 2013, based on comments received by the May 7, 2013, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative NPDES permit and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the revised tentative NPDES permit appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative NPDES permit.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **June 6, 2013, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the **Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California**, will consider the enclosed revised tentative requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the tentative Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
