REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS (WRRs), AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR CITY OF OXNARD, GROUNDWATER RECHARGE, ENHANCEMENT, AND TREATMENT (GREAT) PROGRAM (FILE NO. 08-070, CI-9456)

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff has revised the tentative WDRs and WRRs dated February 12, 2020, based on comments received by the March 13, 2020, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs and WRRs appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **April 09, 2020, at 9:00 a.m., at the Carmel Room, 320 W 4TH St., Los Angeles, California, 90013**, will consider the enclosed revised tentative requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the revised tentative Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to the revised tentative Order. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
