CHANGE OF VENUE, RESPONSE TO COMMENTS, REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs)-PLAINS WEST COAST TERMINALS, LLC, DOMINGUEZ HILLS TANK FARM, COMPTON, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0052949)

Our letter dated February 19, 2016, transmitted the tentative Order for renewal of your permit to discharge waste under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). On March 21, 2016, we received comments on the tentative permit. Staff reviewed the comments, responded and have made changes to the Order based on the responses and an internal review. Enclosed are the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit. Changes in the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES Permit appear in the strikeout/underline format.
