REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT RENEWAL – JOINT OUTFALL SYSTEM, POMONA WATER RECLAMATION PLANT, POMONA, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0053619, CI-0755)

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) staff has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated April 14, 2021, based on comments received by the May 14, 2021 public comments deadline.
