**REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) AND
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT
RENEWAL – JOINT OUTFALL SYSTEM, POMONA WATER RECLAMATION PLANT,
POMONA, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0053619, CI-0755)**
