RESPONSE TO COMMENTS AND REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0110175, CI NO. 6432

We have revised the tentative NPDES permit dated May 3, 2013, based on comments received by the June 3, 2013, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative NPDES permit and written responses to all comments are enclosed. Changes to the revised tentative NPDES permit appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative NPDES permit.

The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
