TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER — SANTA ANITA LAND HOLDINGS, LLC & LOS ANGELES TURF CLUB, INC (NPDES NO. CA0064203, CI-8102)

We have completed our review of your application for renewal of the permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.

Pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the California Water Code, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared. In addition, in response to your request we also prepare the tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) relative to this discharge that will be considered along with tentative permit at the same hearing.

Written comments regarding these tentative Orders must be received at the Regional Water Board office by the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on **May 24, 2018**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised. The Regional Water Board chair may exclude from the record written materials received after this date. (See Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23 § 648.4.)

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and the California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for publication or posting of the notice no later than **April 27, 2018.**

Please notify this Board by telephone when the notice has been published and submit the proof of publication or posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting or publication of the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Water Board no later than **May 4, 2018**.
