REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT, REVISED TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO), AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR CITY OF SIMI VALLEY, SIMI VALLEY WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0055221, CI NO. 3021)

We have revised the tentative TSO, WDRs, and NPDES permit dated March 13, 2014, based on comments received by the April 14, 2014, public comment deadline. A copy of the revised tentative Orders and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs and TSO appear in ~~strikeout~~ and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Orders.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **May 8, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., at the City of Simi Valley Council Chambers, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California**, will consider the enclosed revised tentative requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the revised tentative Orders. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to these revised tentative Orders. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
