CHANGE SHEET TO REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, PEBBLY BEACH DESALINATION PLANT, AVALON, CA (NPDES NO. CA0061191, CI NO. 6899)

Our letter dated November 27, 2019, transmitted the revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) to Southern California Edison (hereafter SCE or Discharger) for wastewater discharges from the Pebbly Beach Desalination Plant (Facility) to the Pacific Ocean. Regional Water Board has continued to discuss with the Discharger their comment request to reduce the receiving water monitoring for salinity from "weekly" to "semi-annually" and subsequently developed a change sheet.
