## CHANGE OF VENUE REGARDING REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS – SANTA CLARITA VALLEY SANITATION DISTRICT, VALENCIA WATER RECLAMATION PLANT, SANTA CLARITA, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0054216, CI-4993)

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) staff has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated March 18, 2022, based on all comments received by the April 18, 2022 public comment deadline.
