REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON TENTATIVE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – COVINA IRRIGATING COMPANY; WILLIAM B. TEMPLE WATER TREATMENT PLANT # 1; GLENDORA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NUMBER CA0060577, CI NUMBER 6849)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board) has completed a review of the application for the renewal of your permit to discharge waste under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program. Pursuant to the federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and in accordance with the California Water Code, tentative waste discharge requirements have been prepared.

Please reference the comments as "Comments on tentative NPDES Permit, Covina Irrigating Company, William B. Temple Water Treatment Plant # 1 CA0060577". Pursuant to section 648.4, title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, untimely submittal of written comments or evidence will not be allowed or accepted into the Administrative Record without a showing of good cause for the delay, and in no event if any party or the Board would be unduly prejudiced by the late submittal including if staff or the Los Angeles Water Board would not have an adequate opportunity to review, consider, and prepare responses to the comments or evidence. Additionally, if the Board receives only supportive comments, the permit may be placed on the Board's consent calendar and approved without oral testimony.
