### **REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT, AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR CITY OF LOS ANGELES, HYPERION TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0109991, CI NO. 1492)**

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff has revised the tentative WDRs and NPDES permit dated August 30, 2016, based on written and verbal comments received by the close of the public hearing on October 13, 2016. A copy of the revised tentative Orders and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.

Note that the USEPA and Regional Water Board held a joint public hearing on October 13, 2016, following a written comment period. At the October hearing, the Regional Water Board closed the comment period and no additional comments were accepted.
