RESPONSE TO COMMENTS ON TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) – AES REDONDO BEACH, LLC; REDONDO BEACH GENERATING STATION; REDONDO BEACH, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NUMBER CA0001201, CI NUMBER 6113)

On October 20, 2021, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board) transmitted the tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for AES Redondo Beach LLC (Discharger), Redondo Beach Generating Station (Facility). Comment letters were submitted on November 19, 2021, by the Discharger, Heal the Bay, and the City Attorney of the City of Redondo Beach. Los Angeles Water Board staff considered the comments submitted and prepared the enclosed Response to Comments and revised tentative TSO.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **December 9, 2021**, at 9:00 a.m., will consider and hear any testimony pertinent to the revised tentative TSO. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing, however, as testimony dictates, the Board, at its discretion, may postpone taking action.
