TRANSMITTAL OF THE AMENDED TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) NO. R4-2016-0221-A01 REQUIRING OWENS-BROCKWAY GLASS CONTAINER, INC., OWENS-BROCKWAY GLASS CONTAINER, INC. FACILITY TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN ORDER NO. R4-2016-0122 - OWENS-BROCKWAY GLASS CONTAINER, INC., OWENS-BROCKWAY GLASS CONTAINER, INC. FACILITY, VERNON, CA. (NPDES NO. Dear Mr. Pittman:

Our letter dated December 5, 2018, transmitted the tentative Amended Time Schedule Order (TSO) to Owens-Brockway Glass Container Inc (Discharger) - Vernon Facility (Facility), and provided an opportunity for public comment. The comment submittal deadline specified was January 4, 2019. Regional Water Board staff did not receive comments regarding the tentative Amended TSO. Therefore, the Executive Officer, pursuant to her delegated authority from the Regional Water Board, administratively issues this Amended Time Schedule Order No. R4-2016-0221-A01 without a public hearing.

The Amended TSO includes a new schedule for removal of the existing exposed furnace air pollution control equipment (Existing Equipment) and a modified expiration date to June 30, 2019. The time extension requested to remove the Existing Equipment will not affect the Facility's ability to comply with the final effluent limitations as it has already been replaced with new furnace air pollution equipment. TSO No. R4-2016-0221-A01 will become effective on January 14, 2019.

A hard copy of this Amended TSO will be sent only to the Discharger. Other interested parties will receive a copy via email. The Amended TSO is also available on the Regional Water Board's website: www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/.
