SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE REVISED DRAFT MONITORING PLAN AND QUALITY ASSURANCE PROJECT PLAN – SFPP, L.P., SFPP NORWALK PUMP STATION, NORWALK, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0063509, CI NO. 7497)

On March 20, 2018, SFPP, L.P. (the Discharger) transmitted a revised Draft Monitoring Plan and Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP) (collectively, the revised Draft Plans) to the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board). The revised Draft Plans were submitted per requirements included in the waste discharge requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit (Order No. R4-2016-0309) for the subject Facility. Section VII.C.2.b of Order No. R4-2016-0309 required the Discharger to implement a Compliance Monitoring Program at the mouth of the San Gabriel River in accordance with the *Dominguez Channel and Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Waters Toxic Pollutants Total Maximum Daily Loads* (Harbor Toxics TMDL). The revised Draft Plans incorporated the Regional Water Board's comments provided on February 26, 2018, on the original Draft Plans submitted by the Discharger on October 30, 2017.

Pursuant to the Harbor Toxics TMDL and consistent with Order No. R4-2016-0309, the revised Draft Plans are being made available for public review and comment. Regional Water Board staff will consider any comments received during the public comment period before approving the revised Draft Plans. The public comment period will begin today, March 30, 2018. The Regional Water Board will evaluate and consider all written comments received by the Regional Water Board **before 5:00 p.m. on April 30, 2018**.
