NOTICE OF HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

TENTATIVE ORDER TO TERMINATE INDIVIDUAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS LOCATED ON TRACT 49240, ACTON, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 91-017, ORDER NO. R4-2026-XXXX, CI-7044, GLOBAL ID WDR100001474)

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) will hold a public meeting to consider adoption of a tentative order terminating Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. 91-059, adopted on April 22, 1991, which regulates the discharge of domestic wastewater from a residential community located on Tract 49240 in Acton, California.
