# Update on the Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed in April 2023 include the following:

- 1. Cleanup of 270 (~95%) out of 285 properties completed.
- 2. On April 10, 2023, the Water Board received documents titled Sub-Slab Soil Vapor Monitoring Reports for five properties located within the former Kast Property: 311 E. 244<sup>th</sup> Street, 24419 Neptune Avenue, 24429 Neptune Avenue, 24423 Ravenna Avenue, and 24742 Ravenna Avenue. The reports summarize sub-slab soil vapor monitoring of volatile organic compounds and fixed gases at the five properties in accordance with the 2014 Revised Remedial Action Plan.

# Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles

Activities related to the environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm conducted in April 2023 are summarized below:

- 1. Recent and ongoing activities for the former Athens Tank Farm site are as follows:
  - a. Phase I and Phase II Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) Systems
    - i. Phase II Horizontal Remediation Wells (HRWs) water from recent heavy rainfall was vacuumed out of the HRWs during the week of April 20. ExxonMobil is evaluating how to remove water from HRWs 202, 204, 205 and 206. These wells have screens completely submerged and require a modified method to remove the water and allow the wells to function.
    - ii. As of February 28, 2023, approximately 713,428 pounds of VOCs and 129,413 pounds of methane have been removed from both Phase I and Phase II SVE systems.
  - b. Phase III NAPL Removal Systems
    - i. Tiered NAPL Recovery Summary
      - a. The NAPL Recovery Trailer continued to operate on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B and ATF-28B; and
      - b. The NAPL Trailer is currently positioned over well ATF-19B and ATF-21B.
        - ➤ NAPL Tier I cumulative recovery as of February 2023, using NAPL Recovery Trailer 3,235 gallons; and

- ➤ NAPL Tier II cumulative recovery as of February 28, 2023 using manual bailing 290.55 gallons.
- NAPL Tier III recovery (oleophilic absorbent socks) are currently deployed in 11 wells: ATF-5B, -10A, -13B, -22B, -26B, -29B; KLFOB-01, -02; and KLFSVE-01 through -03. A cumulative total of 100 absorbent socks have been replaced.

### c. Air/Bio-Sparge System

i. The air/bio sparge system is operating and collecting system performance data. Approximately 250,842 pounds of VOCs have been removed by sparging as of February 28, 2023.

#### Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Stormwater Program Update

The due date for written comments on the tentative General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Facilities in the Dominguez Channel/Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Watershed and the Los Cerritos Channel/Alamitos Bay Watershed was October 24, 2022. The CII Unit received a total of thirty-three written comment letters representing various interests including environmental organizations, municipalities, watershed management groups, various commercial companies, industry coalitions and consulting firms. The CII Unit is working on a response to the written comments. CII staff continues to coordinate with USEPA on any comments on the designation memo that may require revision of the draft CII permit. The CII Unit continues to work on the Stormwater Multiple Application and Report Tracking System (SMARTS) development with the workgroup, which includes staff from the CII Unit, State Water Board Department of Water Quality (DWQ), Division of Information Technology (DIT) and DIT's contractors. The workgroup meets on a weekly basis to develop SMARTS and prepare the database to be functional upon the adoption of the CII permit.

### SB1215 Program Update

The Senate Bill 1215 (SB 1215) Wastewater Consolidation (WWC) Program staff in the Groundwater Permitting Unit continue to work closely with the State Water Board Division of Financial Assistance (DFA), public sewer service providers (SSPs), and a Technical Assistance Provider (TAP), Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC), to facilitate septic to sewer system conversion in priority disadvantaged/severely disadvantaged communities within the Los Angeles Region.

At their May 22, 2023, Board meeting, the Ojai Valley Sanitary District (OVSD) Board of Directors unanimously approved the application process to move forward with the septic-to-sewer conversion projects in the Casitas Springs and Mira Monte communities. Water Board staff is assisting OVSD staff in completing the Planning and Design Application Forms for submittal to DFA.

Staff continues coordination with stakeholders of DACs/SDACs in DFA's fundable list of communities within the region to facilitate funding agreements with DFA for wastewater consolidation.

### Municipal Stormwater Permitting

Staff have completed their review and have conditionally approved all 24 revised WMPs that were submitted in June 2021 in compliance with a 2020 order from the State Water Board. Staff have begun to issue approval confirmation letters to the Permittees participating in a WMP.

## Watershed Regulatory Section

On May 11, 2023, Watershed Regulatory Section staff toured the Pure Water Southern California Demonstration Facility in the City of Carson. Pure Water Southern California is a joint partnership between the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MWD) and Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD) to produce up to 150 million gallons per day of purified water for indirect and direct potable reuse by 2032. The Demonstration Facility is equipped with membrane bioreactors, reverse osmosis, and an ultraviolet light/advanced oxidation process, and is capable of producing up to 500,000 gallons of purified water. Also in attendance were members from Los Angeles City, Water Replenishment District of Southern California, nonprofit environmental groups, and local community organizations.
