Construction Stormwater General Permit Reissuance

On September 8, 2022, the State Water Board adopted the Reissued Construction Stormwater General Permit (CGP) with the new requirements becoming effective on September 1, 2023. Implementation of total maximum daily loads (TMDLs) is one of several new requirements. In preparation for the effective date the State Water Board with assistance by Los Angeles Water Board staff are implementing SMARTS system updates, QSD/QSP roles/responsibility training, workgroup meetings, Regional Water Board CGP workshops and development of the CGP TMDL Map Tool.

On April 25, 2023, the Stormwater Compliance & Enforcement Unit held the first of two public workshops for permittees, owners, environmental professionals, local agencies, and the public. About 150 individuals and groups attended the two-and-one-half hour workshop. The second workshop will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, with about 140 attendees that have registered to attend. The recorded workshop and PowerPoint presentation will be posted to the Los Angeles Water Board's website at a later date. Additionally, the State Water Board will also host an in-person workshop at the Los Angeles Water Board's office on July 11, 2023.

Remediation Sections I and II

Update on the Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed in March 2023 include the following:

- 1. Cleanup of 270 (~95%) out of 285 properties have been completed.
- 2. On March 7, 2023, the Los Angeles Water Board received documents titled Sub-Slab Soil Vapor Monitoring Reports for five properties located within the former Kast Property: 24412 Marbella Avenue, 24406 Neptune Avenue, 24709 Neptune Avenue, 24833 Panama Avenue, and 24716 Ravenna Avenue. The reports summarize sub-slab soil vapor monitoring of volatile organic compounds and fixed gases at the five properties in accordance with the 2014 Revised Remedial Action Plan.
- 3. On March 24, 2023, the Los Angeles Water Board received documents titled *Property-Specific Remediation and Construction Completion Report for Cluster 22* at the former Kast Property. These reports provided an overview of remediation conducted, a summary of homeowner/resident meetings, discussion of construction drawings, permit summary, discussion of the remedial approach for the property, discussion of restoration activities, and long-term monitoring plan.

Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles

Activities related to the environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm conducted in March 2023 are summarized below:

- On March 8, 2023, Los Angeles Water Board staff received an email from Ms. Paola Dela Cruz-Perez with the East Yard Communities for Environmental Justice requesting a meeting to provide an update on the contamination and cleanup efforts at the Site. Los Angeles Water Board staff responded to Ms. Dela Cruz-Perez on March 9, 2023, in an email indicating that the Los Angeles Water Board and Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) staff will evaluate possible dates and times to have an online meeting as requested.
- 2. The Los Angeles Water Board received a March 31, 2023, report entitled "Site-Specific Cleanup Goals Report" prepared by Kleinfelder on behalf of ExxonMobil. The report includes a summary of prior onsite and offsite human health risk assessments, an updated conceptual site model, and revised site-specific cleanup goals for remediation of petroleum hydrocarbons in soil, soil vapor, and groundwater. This revised report was requested in a Los Angeles Water Board letter dated September 7, 2022, and granted an extension in a December 19, 2022, letter.
- 3. Phase I and Phase II Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) Systems

- a. The Phase II SVE remediation system compound electrical transformer failed during operation and maintenance (O&M) activities conducted in early January 2023. A replacement transformer was ordered and installed on March 7, 2023.
- b. The Phase II SVE gas actuator valve was replaced on March 16, 2023, and the Phase II SVE remediation system was restarted.
- c. The Phase II SVE Sensaphone® remote monitoring system installation was completed on March 16, 2023. Due to regular Southern California Edison (SCE) electrical power fluctuations (e.g., brownouts, blackouts, etc.) in the area and shutdowns, the Sensaphone® system will alert staff of SVE system shutdowns. This will allow for a timely response and restart of the Phase II SVE system.
- d. As of December 1, 2022 approximately 710,656 pounds of VOCs and 128,920 pounds of methane have been removed from both Phase I and Phase II SVE systems.
- 4. Phase III NAPL Removal Systems
 - a. Tiered NAPL Recovery Summary
 - i. Batteries, solar panels, and the NAPL recovery drum were replaced in March 2023.
 - ii. NAPL Recovery Trailer continued to operate on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B and ATF-28B; and
 - iii. NAPL Trailer is currently positioned over ATF-19B and ATF-21B well.
 - 1. NAPL Tier I cumulative recovery as of December 1, 2022, using NAPL Recovery Trailer 3,051 gallons; and
 - 2. NAPL Tier II cumulative recovery as of December 1, 2022, using manual bailing 290.55 gallons.
 - 3. NAPL Tier III recovery (oleophilic absorbent socks) are currently deployed in 11 wells: ATF-5B, -10A, -13B, -22B, -26B, -29B; KLFOB-01, -02; and KLFSVE-01 through -03. A cumulative total of 71 absorbent socks have been replaced.
- 5. Air/Bio-Sparge System
 - a. The air/bio sparge system is operating and collecting system performance data. Approximately 250,803 pounds of VOCs have been removed by sparging as of December 1, 2022.

The Underground Storage Tank (UST) Staff Presentation at the Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) Unified Program Annual Training Conference

On March 21, 2023, Dr. Yue Rong and Ms. Maryam Renard presented at the 25th Unified Program Annual Training Conference presented by the California CUPA Forum in Anaheim, California. Dr. Rong spoke about Sustainability in Groundwater Remediation and Ms. Renard spoke about Non-Petroleum Vapor Intrusion Evaluation for UST Low-Risk Closure. The Annual Training Conference provided compliance training for regulators and industry professionals in areas of Underground Storage Tanks, Site Remediation, Hazardous Material Business Plan, Hazardous Waste Permitting, Above

Ground Storage Tanks, and Accidental Release Prevention. In addition, training sessions were offered in technology, enforcement, management/leadership, and emergency response. The conference had approximately 2,500 attendees from state and local regulatory agencies and the environmental consulting industry. Both presentations by Dr. Rong and Ms. Renard spurred active discussions during the Q/A period.

Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Stormwater Program Update

The due date for written comments on the tentative General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Facilities in the Dominguez Channel/Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Watershed and the Los Cerritos Channel/Alamitos Bay Watershed was October 24, 2022. The CII Unit received a total of thirty-three written comment letters representing various interests including environmental organizations, municipalities, watershed management groups, various commercial companies, industry coalitions and consulting firms. The CII Unit is working on a response to the written comments. CII staff continues to coordinate with USEPA on any comments on the designation memo that may require revision of the draft CII permit. The CII Unit is working on Stormwater Multiple Application and Report Tracking System (SMARTS) development with the workgroup which includes staff from the CII Unit, State Water Board Department of Water Quality (DWQ), Division of Information Technology (DIT) and DIT's contractors. The workgroup meets on a weekly basis to develop SMARTS and prepare the database to be functional upon the adoption of the CII SW Permit.

SB1215 Program Update

The Senate Bill 1215 (SB 1215) Wastewater Consolidation (WWC) Program staff continue to work closely with the State Water Board Division of Financial Assistance (DFA), public sewer service providers (SSPs), and a Technical Assistance Provider (TAP), Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC), to facilitate septic to sewer system conversion in priority disadvantaged/severely disadvantaged communities within the Los Angeles Region.

On April 26, 2023, staff met with the Ojai Valley Sanitary District (OVSD) to discuss potential septic-to-sewer projects in the Casitas Springs and Mira Monte communities. OVSD intends to present the septic-to-sewer projects to its Board for consideration on May 22, 2023, to move forward with the wastewater consolidation projects. Staff prepared the Casitas Springs and Mira Monte Design and Planning Funding Applications and presentation materials to assist OVSD in the DFA funding application.

Staff continues coordination with stakeholders of DACs/SDACs in DFA's fundable list of 16 communities to facilitate funding agreements with the DFA for wastewater consolidation.

Attendance at Luskin Lecture Regarding Water, Climate and Environmental Justice

On April 27, 2023, Jim Kang, Supervisor of the Groundwater Permitting Unit attended a lecture on "Journey for Water, Climate, and Environmental Justice," presented by Catherine Coleman Flowers at the UCLA Luskin Center for Innovation (LCI). Catherine is a MacArthur "genius" award-winning activist for her groundbreaking, community-driven work on the previously invisible problem of inadequate water and sanitation infrastructure in rural communities in the United States. Her journey was discussed in the lecture in the broader context of national climate and environmental justice advocacy. The second half of the event featured Catherine in discussion with Joaquin Esquivel, chair of the California State Water Board, and Megan Mullin, faculty director of the LCI. The discussion included the sanitation equity work that will soon be launched by LCI's Human Right to Water Solutions Lab in collaboration with the California Water Board and partners.



Regional Programs Section

Municipal Stormwater Permitting

On December 15, 2022, the MS4 staff received the semi-annual Watershed Management Program (WMP) Progress Reports and Annual Reports per the Regional MS4 requirements. Staff have reviewed both reports and have contacted the Permittees requesting any missing information and submittals and asking for clarification, if necessary, regarding the submitted information. In addition, as guidance for future submittals, staff will be sending a common deficiencies memo to all permittees to facilitate improved reporting and to provide clarification on reporting requirements.

Staff have completed their review and have conditionally approved all 24 revised WMPs that were submitted in June 2021 in compliance with a 2020 order from the State Water Board. Staff have begun to issue approval confirmation letters to the Permittees participating in a WMP.

MOU between Water Boards and Army Corps of Engineers

The Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) establishes a 60-day default reasonable period of time for the Water Boards to act on requests for Clean Water Act section 401 water quality certifications. State laws and regulations impose requirements that often exceed the 60-day timeframe, and the Corps can, and has, deemed Water Board certifications as waived when the board does not act within the timeframe. The Corps has the authority to extend the reasonable period of time up to one year; however, relatively few extensions have been granted and approval is inconsistent across the Corps' district offices. The Corps and the Water Boards have agreed on an MOU to (1) categorically establish longer reasonable periods of time based on project type and complexity; (2) establish a consistent process for requesting extensions; and (3) increase predictability and coordination between the agencies. The MOU became effective on April 28, 2013.

Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program

On April 14, 2023, the Administrative Draft of the proposed General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from Irrigated Lands (General WDRs) was released to the public.

Comments were requested to be submitted by May 15, 2023.

Staff conducted two workshops for stakeholders. The first workshop was held at the United Water Conservation District headquarters in Oxnard, on April 17, 2023. The hybrid workshop was attended by over 150 participants and focused on the Ventura County components of the General WDRs. Spanish interpretive services were available onsite.

On May 1, 2023, Staff held a second in-person workshop at the UC Cooperative Extension-Los Angeles County location in Alhambra, with Spanish interpretive services. This workshop focused on the Los Angeles County components of the General WDRs and was attended by 16 participants.

Throughout May, Staff scheduled follow-up meetings with discharger groups from both counties and local NGOs to discuss specific order details and/or concerns. Staff continues to reach out to additional stakeholder groups including farmworker groups and environmental NGOs. Staff is conferencing with other regions to determine if additional program efficiencies can be incorporated into the General WDRs.

Watershed Regulatory Section

On April 11, 2023, Watershed Regulatory Section staff presented at the Los Angeles WateReuse Chapter Meeting, which was hosted by the LA Cleantech Incubator at the La Kretz Innovation Campus in Downtown Los Angeles. The presentation provided regulatory updates for implementing the State's *Water Supply Strategy*, developing pretreatment best management practices (BMPs) to create higher-quality source water for recycled water projects, and an update on US EPA's proposed primary drinking water standards for PFOA and PFOS. The audience members include recycled water project sponsors, proponents, and industry consultants. The meeting and presentation are available at the WateReuse Los Angeles Chapter website.
