Remediation Sections I and II

Update on the Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed in August 2023 include the following:

- 1. Cleanup of 285 (100%) out of 285 properties completed.
- 2. On August 11, 2023, the Los Angeles Water Board received a document titled Second Quarter 2023 Remediation Progress Report for the former Kast Property. The report summarizes activities related to the remediation conducted from April to June 2023, such as, monitoring of groundwater, light non-aqueous phase liquid recovery and sub-slab soil vapor probe sampling; the outreach conducted with residents in Cluster 24; the annual inspections of sub-slab depressurization systems; and the remediation activities related to the soil vapor extraction/bioventing system.
- 3. On August 31, 2023, the Los Angeles Water Board received documents titled Sub-Slab Soil Vapor Monitoring Reports for two properties located within the former Kast Property: 24727 Marbella Avenue and 24738 Neptune Avenue. The reports summarize sub-slab soil vapor monitoring of volatile organic compounds and fixed gases at the two properties in accordance with the 2014 Revised Remedial Action Plan.
- 4. The Soil Vapor Extraction/Bioventing system is fully operational.
- 5. Concrete work (sidewalk, curb & gutter, ADA ramps) throughout the Carousel Tract is in progress.

Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles

Activities related to the environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm conducted in August 2023 are summarized below:

- 1. Recent and ongoing activities for the former Athens Tank Farm site are as follows:
 - a. Phase I and Phase II Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE) Systems
 - i. SVE remediation wells SVE-04 and SVE-05 were inaccessible in the second quarter of 2023 since the area was fenced off by the Ujima Housing Corporation (UHC). Access negotiations with UHC are ongoing and the wells will be sampled during the next scheduled sampling event once access has been granted; and
 - ii. As of May 31, 2023 cumulative removal to date is approximately 727,784 pounds of VOCs and 134,976 pounds of methane have been removed from

both Phase I and Phase II SVE systems.

b. Phase III NAPL Removal Systems

- i. Groundwater monitoring wells ATF-10A (shallow) and ATF-10B (deep) were still inaccessible during the second quarter of 2023 due to the placement of fencing by the Ujima Housing Corporation (UHC). Access to these wells is currently being negotiated with the UHC. These wells will be monitored and sampled during the next scheduled monitoring event following an access agreement.
- ii. The NAPL Recovery Trailer was non-operational during August 2023 due to a malfunctioning NAPL sensor probe. Clean Earth Technology's (CET's) NAPL sensor probe was repaired and shipped back to the Site. The probe was reinstalled on June 23, 2023. During subsequent startup activities, the probe was not working properly. CET was contacted and they requested the probe be returned for repairs.

iii. Tiered NAPL Recovery Summary

- a. NAPL Recovery Trailer was previously positioned on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B; and
- b. NAPL Trailer is currently positioned over well ATF-19B and ATF-21B and ATF-28B.
 - ➤ NAPL Tier I cumulative recovery as of May 31, 2023, using NAPL Recovery Trailer 3,334 gallons; and
 - ➤ NAPL Tier II cumulative recovery as of May 31, 2023, using manual bailing 290.55 gallons.
 - ➤ NAPL Tier III recovery (oleophilic absorbent socks) are currently deployed in 12 wells: ATF-5B, -10A, -13B, -22B, -26B, -28B, -29B; KLFOB-01, -02; and KLFSVE-01 through -03. A cumulative total of 108 absorbent socks have been replaced as of May 31, 2023.

c. Air/Bio-Sparge System

i. The air/bio sparge system is operating and collecting system performance data. Approximately 250,842 pounds of VOCs have been removed by sparging as of May 31, 2023.

Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Stormwater Program Update

The due date for written comments on the tentative General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional (CII) Facilities in the Dominguez Channel/Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Watershed and the Los Cerritos Channel/Alamitos Bay Watershed was October 24, 2022. The CII Unit received a total of thirty-three written comment letters representing various interests including environmental organizations, municipalities, watershed management groups, various commercial companies, industry coalitions and consulting firms. The CII Unit is working on responses to the written comments and a revised draft CII permit. Staff is coordinating with USEPA on the concurrent release of the response to comments and revised draft CII Permit with USEPA's revised preliminary designation memorandum.

The CII Unit continues to work on the Stormwater Multiple Application and Report Tracking System (SMARTS) development with the workgroup, which includes staff from the CII Unit, State Water Board Department of Water Quality (DWQ), Division of Information Technology (DIT) and DIT's contractors. The workgroup meets on a weekly basis to develop SMARTS and prepare the database to be functional upon the adoption of the CII permit.

SB1215 Program Update

The Senate Bill 1215 (SB 1215) Wastewater Consolidation (WWC) Program staff in the Groundwater Permitting Unit continue to work closely with the State Water Board Division of Financial Assistance (DFA), public sewer service providers (SSPs), and a Technical Assistance Provider (TAP), Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC), to facilitate septic to sewer system conversion in priority disadvantaged/severely disadvantaged communities within the Los Angeles Region.

Staff worked with Ojai Valley Sanitary District (OVSD) to ensure proper completion and submittal of the Design and Planning application for the Casitas Springs, North and South Mira Monte communities, which was submitted to DFA on August 8, 2023.

Staff is also working with OVSD to support completion of the Design and Planning application for the Los Encinos, Arbolada, and Siete Robles communities. On August 16, 2023, staff submitted Technical Assistance Request forms to DFA for RCAC to conduct an income survey to reassess the DAC status of these three communities.

Staff continues coordination with stakeholders of DACs/SDACs in DFA's fundable list of communities within the region to facilitate funding agreements with DFA for wastewater consolidation.

TMDL

On September 19. 2023, California's Office of Administrative Law approved the TMDL for indicator bacteria in Los Cerritos Channel and Estuary, Alamito Bay, and Colorado Lagoon, and the suspension of recreational beneficial uses in Los Cerritos Channel during unsafe wet weather conditions which was adopted by the Los Angeles Water Board on March 10 2022, (Resolution No. R22-002). The TMDL will be in effect when USEPA approves the TMDL.

Watershed Regulatory Section (WRS)

Updates to the Region's Pretreatment Program

On August 31, 2023, the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County's Cross-Media Electronic Reporting Rule (CROMERR) application received U.S. EPA's acceptance. CROMERR allows entities to submit electronic reporting in lieu of paper reports containing wet signatures, while maintaining the authentication and security requirements. The District's CROMERR application is the first in the Region and only one of four within the State. The Los Angeles Water Board will conduct final review of the application to determine whether it satisfies the pretreatment modification requirements.
