Monthly update on COVID requests for Relief from Regional Water Board requirements.

Although the number of new requests has slowed, we continue to receive them from the regulated community seeking relief from permit and other regulatory requirements during the COVID pandemic.

Every request is tracked, including when it was received and the status of the Region's response. All requests receive an email from staff acknowledging receipt of the request and ask for more information if needed. Each request is evaluated, and a response generated providing our assessment for relief based primarily on the expected effect of the proposed action on human health. Recommendations include extend or suspend requirements, extend comment due dates, delay Regional Board action; or deny the request.

Region 4 received 1 request in April bringing the total to 193. In total, we issued 153 responses, of which 122 requests were approved, 31 were denied with one pending review. It is important to note that 39 of the requests were withdrawn, meaning the requestor was able to comply with the requirement in a timely manner.

Remediation Section

Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson - Dr. Teklewold Ayalew, (213) 576-6739 Site Cleanup Unit III

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed during April 2021 include the following:

- 1. On April 1, 2021, the Regional Water Board completed review of the Cluster-Wide Remediation and Construction Completion Report (RCCR) for Cluster 15, and fourteen Cluster 15 and one Cluster 14 (buffer) Property-Specific Remediation and Construction Completion Reports (PSRCCRs) for Remedial Action Plan implementation at the former Kast Property. The cluster-wide RCCR includes an overall summary of remedial actions implemented, methods employed, overall volumes and mass of soil excavated, transported, and either disposed or treated and recycled, and compliance with Project Design Features and Mitigation Measures. It also includes detailed field monitoring records associated with the construction work. The PSRCCRs provide a summary of remedial actions implemented at each individual property.
- 2. On April 1, 2021, the Regional Water Board received twelve (12) *Property-Specific Remediation Plans* (PSRPs) for Cluster 18 properties. The PSRPs describe the plan for implementing the scope of remedial actions. In advance of preparing the PSRPs, Regional Water Board staff and representatives from Shell met with the homeowners and provided information on the overall remediation program and specific remediation activities planned for this cluster of properties as well as temporary housing.
- 3. On April 9, 2021, the Regional Water Board received the document, *First Quarter 2021 Remediation Progress Report*, for implementation of the Remedial Action Plan. The Report summarizes remedial actions implemented including related testing, monitoring, property-specific remediation plans for Clusters 16 and 17, outreach activities, and a list of activities planned for the second quarter 2021. Cluster 16 remediation and restoration was completed on April 9, 2021. Remediation activities completed include excavation and backfill, installation of residential soil vapor extraction (SVE)/bioventing wells and piping, and sub-slab depressurization (SSD) systems. Utility restoration, construction of property line walls, and rough grading are currently in progress.
- 4. On April 15, 2021, the Regional Water Board distributed a meeting notice for Virtual "Office Hours" for the Carousel Tract Community. The notice extends an invitation to the community to participate in the Virtual Office Hours Meetings in which the Regional Water Board staff will be virtually available for 15-minute appointments to meet with individual homeowners and provide an informal setting to talk about cleanup activities, cluster schedules, how individual properties will be cleaned up. The Virtual Office Hours Meetings are scheduled for May 27, June 24, and July 22, 2021.
- 5. On April 30, 2021, Regional Water Board staff completed review of twelve (12) Cluster

18 PSRPs dated April 1, 2021 and approved the proposed remedial action. The PSRPs contain planned cleanup activities for the property consistent with the Regional Water Board approved *Revised Remedial Action Plan* (RAP) and *Remedial Design and Implementation Plan* (RDIP). The approval letter states that in implementing the PSRPs, the Responsible Party(ies) is required to comply with conditions in the Regional Water Board approved Revised RAP and RDIP.

6. Cleanup of 183 (~64%) properties / homes is complete. All work is proceeding on schedule for Cluster 17. As of April 30, 2021, the status of cleanup implementation at the Carousel Tract is as follows:

Clusters 16

a. Remediation & restoration was completed on April 9, 2021 and Cluster 16 residents moved back during the week of April 12, 2021.

Cluster 17

- a. All excavation and backfill, installation of residential SVE/bioventing wells and piping and SSD systems are complete;
- b. Utility restoration, construction of property line walls, and rough grading are in progress;
- c. All homes are undergoing landscape and hardscape restoration (concrete surfaces for driveways, walkways, patios, decorative walls for courtyards, etc.);
- d. Each homeowner has been called to schedule two separate appointments in the upcoming weeks: one for installation of gas meters the week of May 31st and another for a post-construction inspection the week of June 7th; and
- e. Work is on track and to be completed by June 18, 2021.

Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles - Dr. Teklewold Ayalew, (213) 576-6739 Site Cleanup Unit III

Activities related to environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm during April 2021 are summarized below:

 On April 8, 2021, the Regional Water Board received the document, First Quarter 2021 Phase III Groundwater Remedial Progress Report. According to the report, the estimated cumulative mass of VOCs as hexane removed is 176,356 pounds. In addition, the estimated cumulated non-aqueous phase liquids (NAPL) recovery using targeted automated skimming is 1,615 gallons, and 287.86 gallons with manual bailing. In addition, the dissolved oxygen concentrations in each sparge observation well suggest increased consumption by microbes of the supplied dissolved oxygen.

- 2. On April 8, 2021, the Regional Water Board received the document, Quarterly Soil Gas Monitoring Report First Quarter 2021. Overall, probes with low concentrations or no detection of methane and benzene have remained low to not detected, while probes with higher concentrations of methane and benzene have exhibited variability in concentration. - 3. On April 9, 2021, the Regional Water Board received the document, *First Quarter 2021 Phase I/II Soil Vapor Extraction Remedial Progress Report.* The First Quarter 2021 operating period included in this report is from December 1, 2020, to February 28, 2021. Samples for laboratory analysis were collected on December 4, 2020. Soil vapor sample results are evaluated monthly and Phase II screens are turned on/off accordingly. Performance monitoring evaluations are performed on an annual basis and used to determine the effectiveness of the system in each Phase II screen location.
- 4. County of Los Angeles EMJRP/Former UVA Phase 1B Redevelopment Activities are as follows:
 - a. Kleinfelder and ExxonMobil met on-site with Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation and the Los Angeles County outside architect to discuss the remediation facilities and redevelopment of the sports fields and a proposed sports activity center.
- 5. A summary of completed, ongoing and upcoming activities for the former Athens Tank Farm site are as follows:

Phase I Soil Vapor Extraction (SVE)

a. Continue extracting from wells SVE-02 and SVE-11 using the Phase II SVE system.

Phase II SVE

- a. The system is operating and currently extracting from wells HRW-203 (all 3 screens), HRW-205 (all 3 screens), HRW-207 (all 3 screens) and from Phase I wells SVE-02 and SVE-11. Extraction from HRW-204 and HRW-206 has been temporarily suspended due to loss of vacuum in these lines.
- b. As of February 28, 2021, cumulated removals to date are approximately 618,278 pounds of VOCs and 97,195 pounds of methane from both SVE systems.

Phase III Systems

NAPL Recovery Trailer

- a. The NAPL Recovery Trailer is currently operating on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B and ATF-28B;
- b. As of the end of the first quarter 2021, the NAPL Tier 1 cumulative removal using the NAPL Recovery Trailer is 1,615 gallons and NAPL Tier II cumulative recovery using manual bailing is 288 gallons.

San Gabriel Groundwater Basin Presentation

On Thursday, May 20, 2021, Randy Schoellerman, Executive Director of the San Gabriel Basin Water Quality Authority, and Regional Water Board Site Cleanup staff, Bizuayehu Ayele, Jeffrey Hu, and Arthur Heath briefed several State and Regional Water Board members on their respective agency's role in the cleanup of the contaminated groundwater in the San Gabriel Groundwater Basin under Superfund and Prop 1 and 68 projects.

The Regional Water Board presentation focused on the identification of responsible parties and the historical and on-going soil, soil vapor, groundwater assessment and cleanup work. Mr. Schoellerman discussed his agency's coordination of area-wide groundwater cleanups across the various responsible parties and collaboration with the Water Board on the Prop 1 and Prop 68 projects in many of the disadvantaged communities across the impacted San Gabriel Groundwater Basin.

Underground Storage Tank Section

Regional Programs Section

Municipal Stormwater (MS4) Permitting Program

The Municipal Stormwater Permitting Unit continues to prepare the Regional MS4 Permit for Los Angeles and Ventura Counties. The written comment period for the tentative Regional MS4 Permit ended on December 7, 2020. Staff continues to meet with Permittees and stakeholders to discuss comments and requested revisions to the tentative permit. Recent meetings have included:

- On March 30, 2021 Regional Water Board staff met with multiple Permittees to discuss their compliance concerns with the Tentative Regional MS4 Permit. This meeting was in follow up to an earlier meeting staff held to discuss the manner of TMDL incorporation in the Tentative Regional MS4 Permit. Some of the issues/concerns expressed by Permittees were differences in watershed characteristics, upcoming final TMDL compliance dates, potential exceedances and violations after final TMDL compliance dates, and compliance costs. Staff discussed the ways in which these concerns are being addressed in the revised Tentative Regional MS4 Permit.
- On April 21, 2021, Regional Water Board staff met with Ventura County Permittees to discuss their compliance concerns and issues with the Tentative Regional MS4 Permit. Key issues of concern are potential liability for exceedances observed during monitoring, lack of dedicated funding at the level of Los Angeles County, length of time to develop a watershed management program, and compliance with Bacteria TMDLs during wet weather. Staff discussed the ways in which these concerns are addressed in the revised Tentative Regional MS4 Permit.
- On April 27, 2021, Regional Water Board staff met with the Nature Conservancy to discuss their comments on the Tentative Regional MS4 permit.
- On May 6, 2021, Regional Water Board staff met with watershed groups, including the Lower San Gabriel River, Lower Los Angeles River, Los Cerritos Channel, Upper San Gabriel River, Alamitos Bay, and Malibu Creek groups, to discuss progress and approaches for updating RAAs.

Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Program

The State Water Resources Control Board provided public notice of an opportunity to comment on its proposal approval of the Basin Plan amendments recently adopted by the Regional Water Board on March 11, 2021 (Resolution No. R21-001), which extend final TMDL implementation deadlines for nine (9) TMDLs. These 9 TMDLs are: the Santa Monica Bay Beaches Bacteria TMDL; the Marina del Rey Harbor Mothers' Beach and Back Basins Bacteria TMDL; the Malibu Creek and Lagoon Bacteria TMDL; the Malibu Creek Nutrients TMDL; the Malibu Creek and Lagoon Sedimentation and Nutrients TMDL to Address Benthic Community Impairments; the Ballona Creek Estuary Toxic Pollutants TMDL; the Marina del Rey Harbor Toxic Pollutants TMDL; the Ballona Creek, Ballona

Estuary, and Sepulveda Channel Bacteria TMDL; and the Ballona Creek Metals TMDL. The Basin Plan amendment is available for review at: <u>https://www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/water_issues/programs/tmdl/docs/R21-001_RB_RSL.PDF</u>
