Remediation Section

Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed in March 2022 include the following:

- 1. Cleanup of 228 (~80 %) properties has been completed. As of March 31, 2022, the Carousel Tract cleanup status is as follows:
 - a. Cluster 20
 - i. Excavation, backfill, and soil vapor extraction (SVE) and sub-slab depressurization (SSD) installation activities have been completed. Restoration and cleanup work are in progress.
 - b. Cluster 21
 - i. Excavation and backfilling activities have begun.
- 2. On March 11, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board received a document titled the Interim Soil and Sub-Slab Soil Vapor Residential Sampling Report for 24622 Panama Avenue at the Former Kast Property. The report documented the results of methane screening, soil sampling, and sub-slab soil vapor probe installation on December 27, 2021, and sub-slab soil vapor sampling. Methane was not detected at concentrations that present a fire or explosion hazard. The analytical results obtained from sampling of soil and sub-slab soil vapor do not trigger additional sampling or additional interim remedial measures at this residence under the Data Evaluation and Decision Matrix for the Former Kast Property. Based on the results of the human health risk assessment, remediation may include shallow soil excavation to 5 feet below ground surface and installation of soil vapor extraction (SVE)/bioventing wells.
- 3. On March 13, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board issued a response on the review of cluster-wide Remediation and Construction Completion Report (RCCR) Cluster 18 and Property-Specific RCCRs for 10 Cluster 18 properties. The cluster wide RCCR includes an overall summary of remedial actions implemented, methods employed, overall volumes and mass of soil excavated, transported, and either disposed or treated and recycled, and compliance with Project Design Features and Mitigation Measures. It also includes detailed field monitoring records associated with the construction work. The Property-Specific RCCRs for 24518 Neptune and 24519 Ravenna, buffer properties to Cluster 19, will be submitted with the Cluster 19 reports.
- 4. On March 16, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board staff, Shell representative and AECOM consultants held a Technical Consultation Meeting. The agenda items discussed included: SVE/bioventing system data reporting methodology and schedule; SCAQMD Rule 1466 monitoring at 24728 Panama Avenue in Cluster 24;

Discontinuation of semi-annual monitoring of 2010 street soil vapor probes; and Elimination of semi-annual screening of utility boxes and vaults.

Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles

Activities related to the environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm conducted in March 2022 are summarized below:

- 1. On March 23, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board received a document titled Quarterly Soil Gas Monitoring Report – First Quarter 2022 for the former Athens Tank Farm (Site). The quarterly soil gas monitoring program is performed as a quarterly event and includes the monitoring and sampling of on- and off-Site soil vapor probe locations. Overall, probes with low concentrations or no detection of methane have remained low to not detected, while probes with higher concentrations of methane have remained elevated. In general, probes with low concentrations or no detection of benzene have remained low to not detected. This trend will be monitored during future sampling events.
- 2. On March 23, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board issued a response to Leighton's Technical Memorandum Dated September 10, 2021 Comments on behalf of The County of Los Angeles to: (1) ExxonMobil's July 20, 2021, Summary of Site Investigations, Risk Assessments, Remedial Action Objectives and Goals; and (2) ExxonMobil's July 15, 2021, Phase III Sparge Remediation System Update Document Submittal to Leighton Consulting, Inc. (Leighton). Leighton discussed the County's concerns about ExxonMobil's proposed path to closure as described in the July 2021 Summary of Site Investigations, Risk Assessments, Remedial Action Objectives and Goals prepared by Kleinfelder, Inc., The letter addresses a number of the concerns discussed in the memorandum. The comments will also be considered and addressed in a forthcoming response to the subject documents.
- 3. A summary of ongoing and upcoming Redevelopment Activities by the County of Los Angeles of the Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP)/Former Ujima Village Apartments (UVA) Phase 1B project follows:
 - a. Los Angeles County indicated that a new park maintenance yard is to be constructed just north of the north end of Clovis Avenue sometime during 2022.
- 4. Ongoing and upcoming activities for the former Athens Tank Farm site are as follows:
 - a. Phase II SVE
 - i. The repair and replacement of combustion chamber and exhaust stack refractory insulation has been completed and the Phase II SVE system is ready to re-start.
 - ii. As of March 31, 2022, approximately 683,234 pounds of VOCs and 122,195

pounds of methane have been removed by the two SVE systems.

- b. Phase III Systems
 - i. NAPL Recovery Trailer
 - (1) The NAPL Recovery Trailer is currently operating on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B and ATF-28B.
 - (a) As of March 31, 2022, NAPL Tier I recovery is 2,287 gallons; and
 - (b) NAPL Tier II recovery, using manual bailing, is 288 gallons.
- c. Air/Bio-Sparge System
 - i. The system is operating and collecting system performance data.

The Skypark Commercial Properties (Site) is approximately 27 acres in size located in the City of Torrance, California. The Site is owned by the City of Torrance and has been primarily leased to aviation or aerospace-related companies since 1954. Historical industrial activities at these properties released wastes containing volatile organic compounds (VOCs), primarily trichloroethene and tetrachloroethene, which discharge into the ground, resulting in the contamination of soil, soil vapor, and groundwater underneath these properties. The soil vapor and groundwater contamination has migrated to the east/southeast across Crenshaw Boulevard and into the City of Lomita.

Regional Board oversight of the environmental site investigation began in 1991 and staff have been periodically updating the City of Lomita's staff and city council and residents on the status of the investigation and cleanup at the Skypark Commercial Properties and the investigation in Lomita. On April 19, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board Executive Officer and project staff attended the City of Lomita's City Council meeting and provided another update to the City Council on the status of the investigation and cleanup at the Skypark Commercial Properties. Vice Chair Jim Stahl was also in attendance. The update addressed the revised vapor intrusion assessment plan for offsite properties located in the current evaluate need for action zone (ENA Zone Plan) approved by the Regional Board on February 28, 2022, and the interim remedial action plan (IRAPs) for groundwater remediation offsite and on the Hi-Shear property that was submitted on January 31, 2022, and the IRAP for the Lexus, Dasco Engineering and Robinson Helicopter property that was submitted on February 28, 2022. These IRAPs are currently under review and the public will be invited to review and comment on them in the near future.

Underground Storage Tanks

Petersen Ranch Mitigation Bank Site Visit

On April 20, 2022, staff visited the Petersen Ranch Mitigation Bank in the vicinity of Lake Hughes. With over 4,000 acres, the bank is the only mitigation bank in Los Angeles County, the largest bank in the State of California, and one of the largest banks in the United States. It is approved to provide mitigation for permitted impacts under Water Board 401 certifications, US Army Corps of Engineers 404 permits, and California Department of Fish & Wildlife 1600 agreements. It also provides CEQA mitigation for a wide variety of species and habitats. The bank drains into both the Santa Clara River and Antelope-Fremont Valley watersheds, resulting in an expansive wetland/riparian service area that includes portions of Los Angeles, Kern, Ventura, and San Bernardino Counties.

2024 Integrated Report

Section 303(d) of the Clean Water Act requires the identification of water bodies that do

not meet, or are not expected to meet, water quality standards (i.e., impaired water bodies). The affected water body, and associated pollutant or stressor, is then prioritized in the 303(d) List of Impaired Waters. The Clean Water Act further requires the development of a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for each listing. In addition, under Clean Water Act section 305(b), each state is required to report biennially to the U.S. EPA on the water quality conditions of its surface waters referred to as the "305(b) report". In California, the 303(d) List of Impaired Waters and the 305(b) Water Quality Assessment Report are combined into a single report, called the Integrated Report and administered by the State Water Board.

The Los Angeles Region is currently engaged in the 2024 Integrated Report cycle, together with the Regional Water Boards for the San Francisco and Santa Ana regions.

Staff are currently assessing data submitted during the October 2020 data solicitation period. The assessment includes consideration of almost 25,000 new lines of evidence (each line of evidence represents a sampling station/pollutant/beneficial use combination) in order to make listing decisions for each water body/pollutant combination. The Draft Staff Report for the 2024 California Integrated Report is expected to be released to the public in early 2023. A workshop will be organized by the regional boards at that time to discuss the report and hear stakeholders' comments. Adoption by the State Water Board is scheduled for December 2023, followed by submission to the US EPA by February 2024.

Watershed Regulatory Section
