Enforcement Cases Settled

State Board's General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Land Disturbance and Construction Activities (Construction General Permit)

In 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board reached settlement with four companies regarding violations of the Construction General Permit. The Construction General Permit is a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination (NPDES) Permit issued by the State Water Board and enforced by the Regional Boards for construction sites disturbing 1 acre or more of land, and sites disturbing less than an acre and that are part of a large common plan of development or sale. The moneys from these settlements were deposited in the State's Cleanup and Abatement Fund.

- <u>GLC EI Monte LLC</u> paid a \$208,468 penalty for the unauthorized discharge of sediment-laden stormwater into Eaton Wash, and for failing to implement best management practices.
- <u>CLG Hollywood LLC</u> paid a \$92,595 penalty for starting construction on a Marina del Rey apartment complex before obtaining coverage under the Construction General Permit, and for failing to implement best management practices.

 <u>Millennium Partners LLC and Tiffany Chung</u> will pay a penalty of \$39,446 for failing to implement proper erosion control measures at their construction site in Diamond Bar that caused sediment-laden stormwater discharges into Coyote Creek. In addition to the financial sanction, the corporation is prohibited from performing any work in connection with programs administered, funded, or directed by the State Water Board or its nine regional boards for five years.

Clean Water Act Section 401 Certifications/dredge and fill of waters of the United States

• <u>The Petak Family Trust</u> paid a \$70,773 penalty for performing modifications within Altamira Canyon Creek in Ranchos Palos Verdes without a federal Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification. The unpermitted work involved the placement of gabion boxes and a concrete retaining wall and bottom that destroyed wildlife habitat.

Funding of a Rose Foundation SEP through the Coast United Consent Judgement

On May 18, 2021, a notice of entry was served and filed for a consent judgement entered into by the Los Angeles Water Board and Coast United Advertising Co., Inc. d/b/a Coast United Property Management (Coast United). The Consent Judgement addresses Coast United's failure to comply with the terms of Los Angeles Water Board Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R4-2015-0129 (CAO) regarding contamination at the property located at 8710-8722 Darby Avenue, in Northridge, California (Site). Under the Consent Judgement, Coast United was liable for \$4,623,000 in civil penalties, of which \$198,000 was to be paid within one hundred and eighty days of entry of the Consent Judgment to the Waste Discharge Permit Fund or a suitable Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) approved by the Los Angeles Water Board and the Director of the State Water Resources Control Board Office of Enforcement (Enforcement Director). On November 5, 2021, Coast United submitted a payment of \$198,000 to the Rose Foundation for Communities and the Environment (Rose Foundation) for a discrete portion of a larger SEP to be carried out by The Nature Conservancy (TNC) under the Rose Foundation's oversight. The funded SEP is part of the TNC SEP included on the Rose Foundation's 2021 Disadvantaged Community Supplemental Environmental Project List, which was approved by the Los Angeles Water Board Executive Officer on February 17, 2021: the TNC SEP on the 2021 Project List will fund implementation of a rehabilitation project at the Bowtie Parcel, which is located in an area disproportionately affected by environmental pollution. The project will create publicly accessible open space with a natural arroyo and spreading basin to provide water quality benefits and habitat enhancement. The TNC SEP includes discrete sections, and the money paid through the Consent Judgement funds one part of the SEP for sourcing and propagating vegetation locally to rehabilitate the Bowtie Parcel. The SEP began in January 2022 and is to be completed by December 2023. The Los Angeles Water Board will receive quarterly progress report on the SEP.

Update on the July 11, 2021 - Hyperion Treatment Plant Incident

Los Angeles Water Board staff continue to monitor the plant status and effluent quality at the Hyperion Treatment Plant (Hyperion) following the July 11, 2021, unauthorized discharge of raw sewage incident and to investigate the cause of the unauthorized discharge.

As noted in the December 2021 Executive Officer's report, on October 8, the Los Angeles Water Board Assistant Executive Officer issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) and California Water Code (CWC) section 13267 Investigative Order No. R4-2021-0118 (Investigative Order) to LASAN. The Investigative Order required LASAN submit a technical report providing Los Angeles Water Board staff with additional information necessary to further investigate the incident by November 8, 2021. On October 29, 2021, LASAN submitted a request to extend the due date for the technical report to December 17, 2021. The Los Angeles Water Board Assistant Executive Officer approved the extension request on November 8, 2021. LASAN submitted the technical report on December 16, and Los Angeles Water Board staff are in the process of reviewing the report.

On November 30, the Assistant Executive Officer also issued a Notice of Violation to LASAN to address LASAN's failure to perform offshore sampling as required by the CWC 13383 Order and its amendments on 14 different days during the duration of the Order.

Staff continue to be in regular communication with several affected agencies including the City of El Segundo, County Department of Public Health and West Basin Municipal Water District. We are also keeping State Board staff and our State Board liaisons informed and are in communication with our colleagues at U.S. EPA in San Francisco regarding the situation.

Update on the Carson Sanitary Sewer Overflow into the Dominguez Channel

On December 30, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board was notified via a California Office of Emergency Service (Cal-OES) Hazardous Materials Spill Report (Cal OES Control #21-7503) of a sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) from a manhole in the City of Carson, resulting in raw sewage entering the Dominguez Channel. The SSO began in the afternoon of December 30 and continued into the late evening of December 31. As a result, approximately 8.5 million gallons of raw sewage was discharged to the storm drain and subsequently to the Dominguez Channel; multiple beaches in the southern portion of Los Angeles County, including the City of Long Beach, were also closed due to the sewage spill. Los Angeles Water Board staff conducted inspections at the affected sites on December 31, 2021 and on January 3, 2022. Based on preliminary information provided by the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD) on their public website as well as in the certified initial report to the Los Angeles Water Board, the SSO appears to have been caused by the collapse of a 25-foot section of a 48-inch main trunk sewer pipe located on the side of the 110 Freeway offramp to 220th Street in the City of Carson. Due to the collapsed pipe, sewage backed up and was released

from two manholes located at the intersection of 212th Street and Lynton Avenue and the intersection of 212th Street and Moneta Avenue in City of Carson. The overflowed sewage entered an adjacent storm drain at the intersection of 212th Street and Moneta Avenue and flowed into the Torrance Lateral, which is a tributary to the Dominguez Channel.

The collapsed pipe and the manholes are part of the sanitary sewer collection system owned and operated by LACSD and is regulated under the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Board's) General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems (Sanitary Sewer Systems WDRs). As required by the Sanitary Sewer Systems WDRs, LACSD submitted a draft report to the State Board's CIWQS Online SSO Database on January 4, 2021, within 3 business days of the SSO; the report was certified by its due date on January 20, 2022. A technical report, which must contain information such as the causes and circumstances of the SSO, LACSD's response actions, and results of water quality monitoring, is due on February 14, 2022.

LACSD reached out to local residents affected by the SSO and also created a webpage with regular updates on the SSO and repairs to the collapsed sewer pipe. LACSD completed its repairs on the collapsed sewer pipe and site restoration at the 110 Freeway offramp on January 13, 2022. Los Angeles Water Board staff continue to be in regular communication with LACSD staff, are keeping our State Board staff liaisons informed, and are in communication with our colleagues at U.S. EPA regarding the situation.

Update on Dominguez Channel Odors

The Los Angeles Water Board has been coordinating with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works (LACDPW) and the South Coast Air Quality Management District (AQMD) in investigating the sources of the odors from the Dominguez Channel in Carson since October 11, 2021.

As part of the investigation, the Los Angeles Water Board learned of a warehouse located at 16325 South Avalon Boulevard, where millions of pounds of improperly stored alcohol-based products, such as hand sanitizer and anti-bacterial wipes, caught fire on September 30, 2021.

On December 9, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board issued an investigative order and cleanup and abatement order to warehouse owner Liberty Property Limited Partnership and operator Day to Day Imports Inc. to fully understand the extent and impact of discharges of pollutants from the warehouse fire, cleanup the post-fire debris and implement best management practices to prevent any stormwater from leaving the facility.

Remediation Section

Former Kast Property Tank Farm, Carousel Tract Residential Neighborhood, Carson

Activities related to site investigation and cleanup work performed during November and December 2021 include the following:

1. Cleanup of 215 (~75 %) properties is complete. As of November 30, 2021, the status of the cleanup at the Carousel Tract is as follows:

Cluster 19

- a. The rainy weather experienced over the past couple of weeks caused some significant delays. However, all the remediation & restoration work was completed on December 31, 2021; and
- b. Residents are scheduled to return to their homes between Monday, January 3rd and Friday, January 7th, 2022.

Cluster 20

- a. Excavation will continue the first week of 2022; and
- b. An estimated 11 workdays were lost due to rainy weather; therefore, the schedule has been delayed to about 2 weeks.
- 2. On November 2, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board issued the Carousel Tract Fall 2021 Site Cleanup Update. This is part of a continuing community outreach effort to inform cleanup status and include the highlights of the latest progress in the Carousel Tract Cleanup. The remedial work is being conducted on groups of properties referred to as "clusters." The status of the current cluster layout is: Cluster 18 remedial construction work was completed on Friday, October 8, 2021; residents from Cluster 18 moved back starting October 11, 2021; excavation and backfill was completed on the yards of Cluster 19 that require it; and installation of remediation systems for Cluster 19 is currently proceeding.
- 3. On November 10, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board received reports summarizing the results of sub-slab soil vapor sampling at 24406 and 24513 Ravenna Avenue, 24712 Neptune Avenue, and 24803 Panama Avenue at the former Kast Property. Sub-slab depressurization (SSD) systems are required for two of the four properties 24513 Ravenna Avenue and 24712 Neptune Avenue. Sampling of the sub-slab soil vapor probes will continue at these properties until detected constituent of concern (COC) concentrations are below the sub-slab soil vapor site-specific cleanup goals (SSCGs) for two consecutive sampling events following SSD system startup. Sampling of the sub-slab soil vapor probes at 24406 Ravenna Avenue and 24803 Panama Avenue will continue every other year until there have been four

consecutive sampling rounds for at least two probes in which detected concentrations of COCs are below sub-slab soil vapor SSCGs.

- 4. On December 15, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board received a document titled the 2021 2nd Semi-Annual Methane Monitoring Report for the methane mitigation system at 378 E. 249th Street. This report documents the 11th semi-annual event, following 11 quarterly events. Three monthly monitoring events, eleven quarterly monitoring events, and ten semi-annual monitoring events have previously been completed and reported for the methane mitigation system installed at the singlefamily residence. Methane soil gas posed no hazard at the home or garage during this monitoring event. The methane mitigation system at the subject site is operating as intended. With respect to the presence of methane in soil gas, this home can continue to be safely occupied. The methane mitigation system at the subject site is operating as intended.
- 5. On December 17, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board received twelve (12) Property-Specific Remediation Plans (PSRPs) for Cluster 21 properties. The PSRP describes the plan for implementing the scope of remedial actions. In advance of preparing the PSRPs, Los Angeles Water Board staff and representatives from Shell met with the homeowners and provided information on the overall remediation program and specific remediation activities planned for this cluster of properties as well as temporary housing.

Former Athens Tank Farm / Ujima Village Apartments and Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP), Los Angeles

Activities related to the environmental site investigation of the Former Athens Tank Farm during November and December 2021 are summarized below:

- 1. On November 10, 2021, the Los Angeles Water Board received a letter requesting an extension of the due date for the submittal of the Annual Groundwater Monitoring and Remediation Progress Report for 2021. Due to the redevelopment activities conducted by Los Angeles County Development Authority in the former Ujima Village Apartment area, two groundwater monitoring wells could not be accessed in a timely manner, resulting in a delay of sampling, and subsequent laboratory analysis, of those wells. The Los Angeles Water Board is currently reviewing the extension request.
- 2. A summary of ongoing and upcoming Redevelopment Activities by the County of Los Angeles of the Ervin Magic Johnson Regional Park (EMJRP)/Former Ujima Village Apartments (UVA) Phase 1B project follows:
 - a. Phase 1B area was opened to the public on December 4, 2021.
 - b. New Park Maintenance Yard North End of Clovis Avenue:
 - Los Angeles County indicated that a new park maintenance yard is to be constructed just north of the north end of Clovis Avenue; and

- Construction work will potentially start by the end of 2021 and will be finished in 2022.
- a. County of Los Angeles 126th Street Pavement Project will not take place until 2023.
- 3. Ongoing and upcoming activities for the former Athens Tank Farm site are as follows:

Phase II SVE

- a. The system was temporarily shut down for repairs.
- b. As of August 31, 2021, approximately 657,611 pounds of VOCs and 110,914 pounds of methane have been removed by the two SVE systems.

Phase III Systems

NAPL Recovery Trailer

- a. The NAPL Recovery Trailer is currently operating on wells ATF-19B, ATF-21B and ATF-28B.
- b. The NAPL Recovery Trailer is currently positioned over well ATF-19B:
 - i. As of August 31, 2021, NAPL Tier I recovery is 1,910 gallons; and
 - ii. NAPL Tier II recovery, using manual bailing, is 288 gallons.

Air/Bio-Sparge System

a. The system is operating and collecting system performance data.

Former United Technologies Corporation (UTC), Canoga Park Facility

The United Technologies Corporation (UTC) Canoga Avenue Facility includes three parcels comprising approximately 47 acres bounded by Canoga Avenue on the east, Vanowen Street on the north, Owensmouth Avenue on the west and Victory Boulevard on the south. UTC is currently conducting an off-site soil vapor assessment that was scheduled to be completed in the 4th quarter of 2021. However due to access issues this work has been delayed and is now anticipated to be completed in the 1st quarter of 2022. The results of this off-site soil vapor assessment will be uploaded to GeoTracker upon completion and are due to the Los Angeles Water Board by April 30, 2022.

Public Outreach Regarding the Commercial, Industrial and Institutional (CII) Storm Water Permit

On December 7 and 16, 2021, joint USEPA and Los Angeles Water Board meetings were held to discuss potential regulatory requirements for stormwater runoff from certain commercial, industrial, and institutional (CII) facilities in the Dominguez Channel/Greater Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbor Watershed and the Los Cerritos Channel/Alamitos Bay Watershed. An overview of the regulatory background behind the action and the potential requirements and compliance options were discussed. Questions and comments from attendees were answered or compiled for consideration in the drafting of the CII permit.

Regional Programs Section

Municipal Stormwater (MS4) Permitting Program

Board staff is in the process of reviewing the updated Reasonable Assurance Analyses (RAAs) and Watershed Management Programs, which were submitted by MS4 permittees in Los Angeles County that were participating in an approved Watershed Management Program under the 2012 Los Angeles County MS4 Permit. Board staff are also are reviewing Permittees' compliance with milestones in the Watershed Management Programs per the requirements of State Board Order WQ 2020-0038. State Board Order WQ 2020-0038 directed MS4 Permittees participating in an approved Watershed Management Program or Enhanced Watershed Management Program to submit documentation by June 30, 2021, demonstrating that all work associated with current and prior milestones had been completed to retain deemed compliance with the receiving water limitations, water quality-based effluent limitations, and other TMDL-specific limitations.

TMDL

The Los Cerritos Channel and Estuary, Alamitos Bay, and Colorado Lagoon Bacteria TMDL was released for public comment on December 3, 2021 and the 45-day comment period ended on January 18, 2022. Staff received four comment letters from Richard Watson on behalf of the MS4 Permittees participating in the Los Cerritos Channel Watershed Management Program, County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles County Flood Control District, Heal the Bay and US EPA. Staff is currently providing responses to comments. This TMDL will be considered by the Los Angeles Water Board on Feb 10, 2022.

Basin Planning

The State Water Board established definitions for three Tribal Beneficial Uses in 2017. Tribal Beneficial Uses are a group of beneficial uses of waterbodies that acknowledge activities specific to Native American cultures and their uses of California waters, including the consumption of fish or shellfish from non-commercial fishing activities. These three definitions are as follows:

Tribal Tradition and Culture (CUL): Uses of water that support the cultural, spiritual, ceremonial, or traditional rights or lifeways of California Native American Tribes, including, but not limited to: navigation, ceremonies, or fishing, gathering, or consumption of natural aquatic resources, including fish, shellfish, vegetation, and materials.

Tribal Subsistence Fishing (T-SUB): Uses of water involving the noncommercial catching or gathering of natural aquatic resources, including fish and shellfish, for consumption by individuals, households, or communities of California Native American Tribes to meet needs for sustenance.

Subsistence Fishing (SUB): Uses of water involving the non-commercial catching or gathering of natural aquatic resources, including fish and shellfish, for consumption by individuals, households, or communities, to meet needs for sustenance

On January 3, 2022, the Los Angeles Water Board noticed an amendment to the Los Angeles Region's Basin Plan to incorporate the tribal beneficial uses and their definitions, and comments will be accepted until February 17, 2022. Incorporating the Tribal Beneficial Uses in the Basin Plan does not designate any specific waterbodies with the beneficial uses; use designations will require a separate basin planning process. This Basin Plan amendment will be considered by the Los Angeles Board on March 10, 2022.

Harmful Algal Blooms

Harmful algal blooms (HABs) are an increasing and critical issue for Californians. Over the past decade, severe blooms have impacted drinking water systems across the state including the State Water Project. They have been identified in lakes, rivers, and streams in all parts of the state, and have caused suspected illness in humans, pets, livestock, and wildlife. Since the Water Boards began tracking HABs in 2016, the number of HAB incident reports submitted by the public, Water Board staff, and local agencies annually has sextupled (580+ new reports already for 2021). These are represented on the webbased <u>HAB Incident Report map</u>.

The Water Boards' Surface Water Ambient Monitoring Program (SWAMP) began developing a Freshwater and Estuarine Harmful Algal Bloom (FHAB) program in 2014. SWAMP prepared a California Freshwater HAB Assessment and Support Strategy to articulate the goals of the program to provide response, assessment, and communication of statewide occurrences of HABs.

AB 834 established the Freshwater and Estuarine Harmful Algal Bloom Program in 2019, which directs the State Water Board to lead a FHAB program including the California Water Quality Monitoring Council, Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment, State Department of Public Health, Department of Water Resources, Department of Fish and Wildlife, Department of Parks and Recreation, other appropriate state and federal agencies, and California Native American tribes. The Water Boards' FHAB program was staffed with 5 PYs (2 at the State Water Board; 3 at three Regional Water Boards [1, 5, & 6]) in the summer of 2021 and has begun collaboratively addressing several of the key requirements within the new legislation, including monitoring and assessment, risk assessment, research, outreach and coordination of immediate and long-term event incident response.

Los Angeles Water Board FHAB program

Los Angeles Water Board staff responds to FHAB incidents that are reported to the Los Angeles region via the FHAB reporting portal and/or the CalEPA complaints portal. Response typically involves coordination between the cities or entities where the incident was reported, and a site visit and collection of water samples. If photos of the incident are provided in the report, staff use these to conduct an initial screening of the FHAB incident. In past incidents, staff have collected water samples for cyanotoxin analysis. However, if the local city or parks department can conduct the sample collection, staff support their efforts as needed. The FHAB program will also provide warning sign templates depending on the visual and chemical results for the local city or entity to use. In addition to incident response, the Los Angeles Water Board funded a study at SCCWRP using SWAMP funds to investigate and characterize FHABs. Phase 1, conducted in 2020, characterized FHABs across 17 recreational lakes. Phase 2 of the project is sampling three targeted waterbodies (Legg Lake, Lake Machado and Lake Piru) seven times starting in June and ending after Labor Day in September 2022. All lakes have been sampled for Cyanobacteria, Chlorophyll-a biomass, Cyanotoxins, and total Nitrogen and total Phosphorus. The final project report will be submitted to the Los Angeles Water Board by November 2022.

Watershed Regulatory Section

On January 5th and 6th, 2022 Los Angeles Water Board staff attended the 5th in a series of workshops hosted by the National Water Research Institute (NWRI) of the Independent Advisory Panel for the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) Regional Recycled Water Program. The panel reviewed the tertiary membrane bioreactor testing results and provided input on the nitrification and denitrification bench and pilot-scale testing results for primary treatment and the secondary membrane bioreactor testing and monitoring plan. The results from this testing will be used to identify the treatment technologies MWD will use in its final design. A report on the expert panel findings is forthcoming.

Summary of Inspections

No NPDES or WDRs/WRRs permitting and pretreatment inspections were conducted during this reporting period.

Summary of General Permitting Unit Activities

During the months of November and December 2021, two dischargers were enrolled, one enrollment was revised, and eight enrollments were terminated under the general NPDES permits. There are currently 43 enrollments and terminations in process.
