This is in response to the letter directed to this company dated December 18, 2015 and signed by Samuel Unger, and Investigative Order # R4-2015-0282 that accompanied said letter.

Reply Statement

No discharges to sumps or ponds have occurred during the period in which Joro Incorporated has owned and /or operated the oilfield we operate in.

Joro Incorporated has not drilled any oil wells so there are no fluids associated with drilling practices.

Joro Incorporated operates 8 oil wells that produce on average a combined total of about 33 barrels of oil per day. The wells also produce a combined total of about 30 barrels of water per day. We are a low volume producer.

The produced fluids go from the wells by pipelines to a wash tank where the fluids separate. The oil floats to the top of the tank and goes to sales. The water settles to the bottom of the tank and goes by pipeline to a water disposal well where it is injected into a below ground formation far below the surface.


