Hi Jay,

This is the sump we wanted to inspect.

In this case could you please provide the following information:

- The detailed description of the usage:
 - what was the sump used for (the operators used it to drain water out of the stock tanks)
 - how often was the sump used (normally once a day)
 - Any water sample, if so what were the results of analysis(no water sample was taken from this tank.)
- The detailed description of the removal including:
 - the time of the removal (08/12/2015)
 - how it was removed and if it was underground (it was picked with a backhoe. It was buried to a depth of about 6")
 - any stains observed in soil after removal (There was little bit of contaminated soil that was removed and taken to the landfill)
 - What was the steel condition at the time of removal(Tank was little bit rusty, but no holes or any leak)
 - any soil excavation(there was little bit, around 25 gallons, of contaminated soil that was collected into a 55 gallon drum.
 - any soil samples, if so what were the results of analysis(No soil sample was collected)
